- <u>Archery</u> Archery is a sport involving shooting arrow with a bow. The participant is called an archer.
- <u>Boxing</u> Boxing is a sport involving persons throwing punches at each other in a boxing ring. They wear protective gloves. The persons are called boxers.
- <u>Badminton</u> Badminton is a sport in which two players use racquets to hit a shuttle cock across a net. The participants are called badminton players.
- <u>Cycling</u> Cycling is a competitive physical activity using bicycles. The participants are called cyclists.
- Football Football is a sport played between two teams with a spherical ball. Each team consists of 11 players. In this sport players have to strike a goal. The players are called footballers.

- <u>Hockey</u> Hockey is a sport played between two teams. The players use a curved stick to hit a hard ball. The players are called hockey players.
- <u>Running –</u> Running is a sport where participants have to cover a long distance on continuous high speed. The participants are called runners.
- <u>Shooting</u> Shooting is a sport using various types of guns like rifle and pistol. The participants are called shooters.
- <u>Swimming</u>- Swimming is a sport where a swimmer moves through water. The sport takes place in pools or open water.
- <u>Tennis</u> Tennis is a sport played between two players using tennis racket to strike a hollow rubber ball in the opponent's court.
- <u>Weightlifting</u> Weightlifting is a sport where the athlete attempts to lift a maximum weight. The participant is called a weightlifter.
- <u>Wrestling</u> Wrestling is a sport in which two opponents struggle hand to hand to pin down or press each other's shoulder to the ground. The participants are called wrestlers.
