### Past form of Verb to have

(To be done in c/w copy)

1. Past form(অতীত রূপ) of 'have'= had(ছিল) (কোনো জিনিস ছিল অর্থে)

2. We use 'had' after singular and plural number.

3. Frame sentence as directed:

Ans: The chair had four legs. (Affirmative sentence)

b) He + Past form of verb to have+ no/not + Rest.

Ans: He had no friend. (Negative sentence)

OR

He had not a/any friend. (Negative sentence)

**c) Past form of verb to have + Subject (pronoun in plural) + Rest?**

**Ans: Had they an old car? (Interrogative sentence)**

**Ans: We had not many books. (Negative sentence)**

**Had we many books? (Interrogative sentence)**

**b) The poor boy had no food. (Affirmative & Interrogative)**
